Directions: If you are new to the Horses4Heroes Family Equestrian Center, here are driving directions:

**From the 95 North: Take the 95 North to Craig Road. Turn LEFT, head west. Turn RIGHT on Buffalo, turn LEFT on Lone Mountain, turn RIGHT on CONOUGH LANE (second street west of Buffalo). Turn RIGHT on La Madre and enter off La Madre and PARK IN OUR LOT, NOT IN THE DRIVEWAY. NO PARKING ON THE STREET PER THE COUNTY. From the 215: Take the Lone Mountain exit, head east, turn LEFT on CONOUGH (one street before Buffalo), RIGHT ON La Madre. *Yes, we are located on Miller, but our entrance is off La Madre. Our neighbors on Miller are important to us and our ability to stay in this location. They are not happy with traffic on Miller nor the speed of the cars, which is outside our control. The posted speed limit in the Rural Neighborhoods is 25 MPH. Please access the ranch from CONOUGH and turn on La Madre.***

**Check In:** Check in is between 8 and 9:00. Camp will start at 9:00. Camp is over at 3 pm. We offer Late Pick Up between 3:30 and 5:00 pm for \$10 per camp, per camper. If you need to drop off between 7 am and 8 am, the charge is \$10 per camp per camper. **Attire:** Campers are expected to wear shorts, capris, or pants, closed-toe shoes and a t-shirt. **All pants and shirts, tops must meet CCSD dress code standards or higher.** No sweatpants or anything baggy. No short-shorts or low-cut pants or shorts, no crop tops. **No dresses, skirts or skorts.** Kids will be playing hard all day and we want all body parts to stay where they are supposed to be! Campers may bring a change of footwear but closed toe shoes are always required at camp! Jackets or sweatshirts are recommended as we head into cooler mornings and evenings.

Please provide lunch for your camper and a morning snack. We provide **ice water, but the camper is responsible for his/her own water bottle.** We have a limited number of cups! You are encouraged to send your camper with extra snacks as they get very hungry throughout the day! Please send your child with sunscreen, chapstick and anything else need to stay cool/warm and comfortable. After lunch we open the **SNACK BARN**, where we sell frozen treats, ice cream, Hostess items and chips. **All campers will receive ONE FREE SNACK.**

**Behavior:** Campers are expected to follow our three rules: **NO RUNNING NEAR THE HORSES, NO YELLING, SCREAMING AROUND THE HORSES, AND ALL must be good listeners.** Campers are expected to bring an open mind and a fun-loving camp spirit. We will sing songs, play team building games, and have a great time (activities vary depending on the ages of campers, number of campers and weather) Campers are expected to listen to staff and counselors and show them respect as we will in turn show our campers respect. No campers are permitted to chase the dogs, rabbits or other animals and we will leave the ranch cleaner than when we started. **Respect:** The ranch is our place of business. We work very hard to maintain the ranch and to purchase play equipment, tack, etc. to be enjoyed, not destroyed.

**We expect campers to treat our ranch, our games, toys, play equipment, etc. BETTER than they would treat theirs at home. It is not OKAY to break our games, vandalize our tables and walls, or do anything to cause harm to the Ranch, our animals, or the items that have been donated or we have purchased to be enjoyed by all guests and campers.**

**Helmets:** If you have one, bring it, otherwise you can wear one of ours. We cannot always guarantee a well-fitting helmet so bringing your own is best. **We only allow helmets rated for equestrian activities.** Make sure the helmet is well marked with the camper's name.



**No Phone Zone:** Our Ranch and our Camp is a NO PHONE ZONE. Cell phones, tablets, and all electronic devices should remain home or in a backpack. It is best to leave all valuables at home. If you need to reach your child during camp, you can text us at **702.413.8701** and we will connect you.



We are looking forward to a super fun Camp. Please remind your kid(s) that this is camp, not free time at the ranch. Campers will be asked and expected to work in pairs and as a team, follow instructions, be respectful to their fellow campers, as well as the instructors and the counselors. In addition to riding and working with horses, campers will participate in games, chores, team-building activities, etc. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
