Directions: We are NO LONGER IN FLOYD LAMB PARK. If you are new to the Horses4Heroes Family Equestrian Center, here are driving directions:

Take the 95 North to Craig Road. Turn LEFT, head west. Turn RIGHT on Buffalo, turn LEFT on Lone Mountain, turn RIGHT on Miller (first street west of Buffalo). Enter off La Madre and PARK IN LOT, NOT IN THE DRIVEWAY. NO PARKING ON THE STREET. From the 215: Take the Lone Mountain exit, head east, turn LEFT on Miller (one street before Buffalo), enter off La Madre. Speed limit on Miller is 25 MPH. Please respect our neighbors.

1)Check In/Payment: Check in is between 8 and 9:00 am. Camp will start at 9:00 am. Payment is via cash, VENMO, or credit card. Pick-up time is between 3:00 and 3:30 pm. You can add Snack Barn money to their account during drop off. If you need early drop between 7 am and 7:45, it's an extra \$10 per camper per day. Late Pick Up, 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm is \$10 per day camper per day.

Paying with Venmo: You can pay via VENMO starting at 8 AM Sunday morning through 5 pm Monday. Remember, there are no refunds, only credit, WHICH MUST BE USED BY 05/31/2023.

Fees

Ranch Camp, Week 1 (Monday-Friday)

\$200 per week per camper, plus a \$25 registration fee per camper. Snack Barn items are \$1 each, please no more than \$2 per camper per day. One snack per day is included in the registration fee.

Ranch Camp, Week 2 (Tuesday-Friday)

\$175 per week per camper, plus a \$25 registration fee per camper. Snack Barn items are \$1 each, please no more than \$2 per camper per day. One snack per day is included in the registration fee. If you register your child for both weeks, we will waive the Week 2 Registration Fee.

Horse Lovers Camp, Week 1 (Monday-Friday)

\$350 per week per camper, plus a \$50 registration fee per camper. Snack Barn items are \$1 each, please no more than \$2 per camper per day. One snack per day is included in the registration fee. There is no charge for Early Drop Off. **Camp registration fee also includes a Grooming Kit, one per camper.** (If you attend both weeks, you will receive only one grooming kit.)

Horse Lovers Camp, Week 2 (Tuesday-Friday)

\$300 per week per camper, plus a \$50 registration fee per camper. Snack Barn items are \$1 each, please no more than \$2 per camper per day. One snack per day is included in the registration fee. There is no charge for Early Drop Off. **Camp registration fee also includes a Grooming Kit, one per camper.** (If you attend both weeks, you will receive only one grooming kit.) Sign up for both weeks and we will waive the Week 2 Registration Fee.

2) Attire: Campers are expected to wear long pants, closed-toe shoes and a t-shirt. All tops must meet CCSD dress code standards or higher. No sweatpants or anything baggy. Jeans with holes, rips and tears should not have any tears or skin showing more than 4 inches above the knee. No short-shorts or low-cut pants or shorts. **No dresses, skirts or skorts.** Kids will be playing hard all day and we want all body parts to stay where they are supposed to be! Campers may bring a change of footwear, but closed toe shoes are always required at camp! **Jackets or sweatshirts are recommended as we head into cooler mornings and evenings. Gloves are great to keep little hands warm. Make sure every item is well marked.**

3) Lunch and Morning Snack: Please provide lunch and a morning snack for your camper. **We will provide water, but the camper is responsible for his/her own refillable, marked water bottle.** You are encouraged to send your camper with extra snacks as they get very hungry throughout the day! Please send your child with anything else needed to stay warm and comfortable. **After lunch we open the SNACK BARN, where we sell packaged chips and sweet treats. All snacks are \$1 each.** During camp, we will roast marshmallows, usually around 2:30. Campers are not allowed to bring cash to camp.

4) Behavior: Campers are expected to follow our three rules: NO RUNNING NEAR THE HORSES, NO YELLING, SCREAMING AROUND THE HORSES, AND ALL must be good listeners. Campers are expected to bring an open mind and a fun-loving camp spirit. We will sing songs, play team building games, and have a great time (activities vary depending on the ages of campers, number of campers and weather). Campers are expected to listen to staff and counselors and show them respect as we will in turn show our campers' respect.

5) Helmets: If you have one, bring it, otherwise you can wear one of ours. We cannot always guarantee a well-fitting helmet so bringing your own is best. We recommend, of course, a helmet rated for equestrian activities. Bicycle or Skateboard helmets are NOT permitted. **We do not recommend purchasing an equestrian helmet if this your child's first time at camp.**

6) Counselors: We have teenagers who are volunteering time to serve as student counselors during camp. Their role is to be good role models, facilitate the camp experience and help supervise activities. There are always adults on property during camp. Counselors are here to help the adult staff and volunteers.

7) Camp is a NO PHONE ZONE. No electronic devices of any kind are permitted.

8) Medications: If your child is on medication, please advise us and if doses need to be taken during camp, please advise our Director or Camp Mom to administer. If your child needs an EPI Pen or Inhaler, please advise our Director or Camp Mom and we will keep it safe during camp. Campers are not permitted to have an Inhaler with them during camp.

9) No Valuables: Camp is not a place for valuables. Please check and make sure your camper has their jackets, sweatshirts, water bottles, lunch boxes and backpacks. **NO CASH, PLEASE.**

10) Early Drop Off/Late Pick Up: If you need to drop off between 7 am and 7:45, or Late Pick Up, 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm, we will charge an extra \$10 per camper per day. Let us know in advance if you need early drop off. You can sign up when you register on Active Camps.

We are looking forward to a super fun week of camp. Please remind your kid(s) that this is camp, not free time at the ranch. Campers will be asked and expected to work in pairs and as a team, follow instructions, be respectful to their fellow campers, as well as the instructors and the counselors. In addition to riding and working with horses, campers will participate in games, chores, team-building activities, etc. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
